

Civil Society Organizations review the completion of 2 Years of the 'National Common Minimum Program' (Delhi, 24 May 2006)

**We**, representatives of civil society in India, seek the fulfillment of the following promises made in the National Common Minimum Program (NCMP) in 2006-07:

- 1. Adopt the **Right to Education Bill** with suggested amendments & allocate **6% of the GDP** on Education.
- 2. Allocate 3% of the GDP on Health and strengthen the National Rural Health Mission.
- 3. Ensure the inclusion of Dalits, Adivasis, women and disabilities in the implementation of the National Rural Employment Guarantee.
- 4. Enact the Women's Reservation Bill in Parliament.
- 5. Adopt the **Forest Rights Bill** with suggested amendments and strengthen the implementation of the Land Reforms Act.
- 6. Enact the **Communal Violence Bill 2005** with amendments and abolish the Armed Forces Special Powers Act.
- 7. Develop a comprehensive **Central legislation on reservation** in the private sector for dalits and adivasis.
- 8. **Stop forced eviction** and ensure a **comprehensive policy for rehabilitation** against displacement and natural disasters.
- 9. Stop the **privatization of basic services** and the imposition of user fees on the poor.
- 10. Ensure the **participation of Elected Local Bodies** (rural & urban) in all development plans and projects.
