GINGKO FELLOWS 2 DAYS LEARNING VISIT TO INDIA



Under the Ginkgo Fellow "Overseas Study Tour Program" the Fellows from China visited Delhi for two days, i.e., 20th and 21st September 2018 to learn from Indian NGOs, People Organization/Communities, and social entrepreneurs in India.

Wada Na Todo Abhiyan (GCAP India) hosted the Learning Visit of the Ginkgo fellows in Delhi. On **20th September 2018**, a close consultation was held at NFI introducing them to the Indian Social Fabric, the constitution of India and Civil Societies. Furthermore, conferred an idea on distinct issues like Youth Development, Women Empowerment, State and Civil Society Response on Persons with Disability and other relevant issues. They spoke about the Constitution of India, socially excluded communities, Community Led Organisations and various initiatives in India.

On **21st September 2018**, The Ginkgo Fellows visited the youth house of Ropio Foundation (Reach Out and Pass It On) and were escorted in small groups through the slums of Ramesh Nagar, Delhi- for an eye-opening and enlightening experience of the Slums in India.



STRATEGY MEETING ON SDGS.



Date: 4th October 2018

The strategy meeting on SDGs with the CSOs and delegates from the South Asian region was attended by several regional participants including delegates from outside India (Nepal, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, and Sri Lanka). They shared the experiences on SDGs processes and working with the government in their country. Furthermore, enriching the discussion, the house resolved on some action points for monitoring and implementation of the SDGs in the region.
